Grace Smith House is dedicated to providing collaborative and critical community education. Our educators use interactive discussion to engage participants in essential conversations that use real life scenarios to teach prevention and intervention skills, and boundaries. Our education trainings are FREE and trainings can range from 40 minutes to 2 hours or longer. Most are available virtually or in person.

LOVE SHOULDN'T HURT: TEEN DATING VIOLENCE

Provides a foundation of the cycle of violence and how to identify the red flags of an unhealthy relationship. Participants will gain tools and language that will enable them to support a friend who is in an unhealthy relationship, as well as gain an understanding of the impact that dating violence has on the individual, friends, and family. Intended audience: 8th grade and older.

KNOW MORE: SAFETY PLANNING

This is a follow up workshop to Love Shouldn't Hurt: Teen Dating Violence. Participants will gain knowledge and skills of how to increase safety while in an unhealthy relationship, as well as during and after a break up. Intended audience: 8th grade and older.

LOVE SHOULDN'T HURT: DIGITAL ABUSE

This is a follow up workshop to Love Shouldn't Hurt: Teen Dating Violence. Many unhealthy behaviors in a relationship are normalized among teens, especially when it comes to using technology. Participants will learn the red flags of digital abuse and how to start a conversation about setting digital boundaries. Further, participants will gain knowledge on how to support a friend, including laws and resources that can assist. Intended audience: 8th grade and older.

#CONNECT4RESPECT: BULLYING & CYBERBULLYING

Provides the foundation for identifying bullying and its three forms, provides the different types of technology used to cyber bully, as well as the impact bullying and cyber bullying has on the individual, family and friends. Educates the participants to be helpful, supportive, and seek help when faced with witnessing bullying or cyberbullying situation. Intended audience: 3rd grade and older.

#RELATIONSHIPGOALS: BUILDING RESPECTFUL & EQUITABLE RELATIONSHIPS

Relationships are built on a foundation of respect and equity. Participants will gain tools and language that will enable them to build healthy friendships and/or dating relationships, as well as gain an understanding of boundaries and how to set them in a relationship. Can be done in one session or as a series. Intended audience: 9th grade and older. Cannot be provided virtually.

COUPLETS: DEFINING LOVE

This lively workshop of eight short videos show how a conflict-free situation in a healthy relationship becomes toxic in an unhealthy relationship. Participants will learn to identify warning signs and ways to talk to friends or peers when they see unhealthy behaviors. In this workshop we are talking about ALL relationships, not just romantic relationships. Intended audience: 6th - 8th grades.

IN THEIR SHOES: TEENS AND DATING VIOLENCE*

An experiential training designed to help participants understand, in a very limited period of time, the ups, downs and choices a teen in an abusive relationship has to go through as they navigate their situation. In Their Shoes is meant to encourage everyone to think innovatively about the ways we can work to end abuse in relationships together. Requires at least 2 hours for completion. Intended audience: 8th grade and older. Cannot be provided virtually.

ESCALATION*

Escalation's mission is to provide young people with the tools to recognize the warning signs of relationship abuse, understand the difference between healthy and unhealthy behaviors, and safe ways to intervene and help a friend. Additionally, this training inspires young people to end relationship violence in their communities Requires 2 hours for completion. Cannot be provided virtually. Intended audience: 9th grade and older.
